Dr (Tmt) S Usha, Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education was unable to attend the meeting.

Dr. L. Arockiam thanked the institution for supporting research and requested the management to create a separate directorate for research and consultancy. He also insisted to promote diversity in admission and appointments, the publication of books and complete autonomy of courses. In addition, he suggested revamping the workshop into a job development centre for the students to improve their skills. In response, Fr. Principal welcomed to the idea of a research centre but stated that finance was a constraint to build a centre. Fr. Rector added that an empowerment centre was created recently.

Dr S Sahaya Sathish made a request to arrange lectures on getting patent rights. He also insisted to build hostels for UG students. Rev. Fr. S Aruldoss SJ recommended that a scientific study should be made in all aspects. The format of the achievements should be organised in terms of categories like students and faculty development.

Rev. Fr. Thomas Alexander SJ appreciated the management for conducting a job fair for differently-abled students. He also advised the staff members to create modules for MOOC Online courses.

Fr. Rector thanked everyone present and thanked Fr. Provincial for his appreciations. The meeting came to a close at 1.30 pm followed by lunch.

#### **Action Taken Report:**

A Committee is appointed to study the functioning of Five PG Programmes (M.A. History, M.A. Human Resource Management, M.A. Tamil, M.Sc. Electronics and M.Sc. Information Technology). Based on the recommendations, these five programmes are suspended.

Three new programmes viz M.A. Counselling Psychology, M.Sc. Data Science and B.Com Honours were introduced. Approval letters are received from our university.

Rev. Fr. Provincial & Chairman had appointed a University Committee consisting of Core Committee, Executive Committee and Advisory Committee on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to work out the possibilities of St. Joseph's to become a University.

#### OTHER DEPARTMENTS

#### **DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)**

The Minutes of the Board of Studies Department of Business Administration (MBA) were presented by Rev. Dr. V. Joseph Xavier, SJ, Director – MBA, (JIM)

All the courses will be of 3 and 1.5 credits. Apart from foundational, functional, core and other specialization areas, a student will have skill-based courses and a socially relevant programe in the first year. The total number of credits will remain to be 120 (apart from 4 extra credits for SHEPHERD program) for successful completion of MBA programme at JIM.

In the first semester, there will be seven (7) foundational courses of 3 credits each and another two (2) courses of 1.5 credits each. In addition, there will be a certificate course on Communicative Competence and one(1) skill based course - Skills for Management Education carrying two credits.

In the first year, second semester, there will be eight courses in functional and other core areas of management carrying 3 credits each. Also, there will be 4 skill-based courses. Two courses viz., Business Analytics and Business Communication – II will carry two credits each.

In the second year, there will be 2 core courses in each semester. There are 4 specializations. In each specialization, (viz) Finance / Marketing / HR / Systems, there will be five 3 credit courses and three 1.5 credit courses, for both the semesters.

In the second year, students will have to choose a major specialization of his/her choice. In the third and fourth semester, he/she has to compulsorily take 3 courses of three credits each in the chosen specialization.

For the second specialization, he/she must choose 2 courses of three credits each in the third and fourth semester.

Apart from that he/she can choose 4 courses of 1.5 credits each across specializations in the third and fourth semester.

#### **B.Sc. VISUAL COMMUNICATION**

Prof. S. Tamilarasi, Head-in-charge of the Department of Visual Communication Technology read out the minutes of the Board of Studies of the Department of Visual Communication Technology.

She listed the changes to be made in the syllabus.

In Arts and Aesthetics paper, a new unit on Renaissance art can be added.

In Media Culture and Society paper, Unit III the Impact of Media on Culture title has to be elaborated and in Unit V, the term "culture" should be replaced with 'mainstream culture'.
