1. APPROVAL AND PASSING OF THE MINUTES

I. MINUTES OF THE 56th GOVERNING BODY MEETING HELD ON 15th OCTOBER 2020

The 56th Governing Body meeting was held on 15th October, 2020 in SAIL Hall at 11.00 am. It was held in blended mode (both offline and online).

Introduction/ Initiation

The 56th Governing Body meeting was initiated by Rev. Dr Leonard Fernando SJ, Vice Chairman of Governing Body and Rector, St. Joseph’s College (Autonomous),

Tiruchirapalli. In his introductory remarks, he spoke of the effective use of technology in academic activities during the Covid -19 pandemic.

Prayer and Welcome

Rev. Dr L. John Peter Arulanantham SJ, Vice-Principal led the prayer using video display. Rev. Fr. Principal Dr M. Arockiasamy Xavier SJ, Secretary of the Governing Body welcomed the members of the Governing Body. He expressed his sincere thanks to the former members and introduced the new members.

1. APPROVAL OF THE PASSING OF THE MINUTES

The minutes of the 55th Governing Body meeting held on 22nd January 2020, was read by Dr A.N. Paul Angelo, Dean-School of Physical Sciences. It was unanimously accepted and passed. The minutes of the 44th Academic council meeting held on 5th August 2020 was read by Dr Y. Dominic, Dean-School of Computing Sciences. Prof. P.P. Mathur, UGC representative expressed that many graduates are finding it difficult to get jobs. Similarly the companies are also finding it difficult to get the right work force. So, he requested the college to fine tune the curriculum, which will fetch enough placements to the students. He also suggested that more electives (of industrial demand) could be offered to students in order to enhance placements. Mr C. Selvam, Business Expert KPIT Technologies, Pune suggested a few electives and of the view that a tie-up between a company and an educational institution will help the students to get job. After the discussion the minutes of the 44th Academic council was accepted and passed.

2. ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Admission Particulars

Dr G. John, Dean-School of Management Studies read out the details pertaining to the college admission. A total number of 986 students were admitted in I UG (Shift-I) and 1034 students in I UG (Shift-II). Two hundred and eighty two (282) students were admitted in I PG (Shift-I), 361 in I PG (Shift-II) and 110 in MBA. Overall students' strength of the college is 7,383 (UG-5,623, PG- 1,530 and MBA- 230).

Result Analysis

Dr S. Alfred Cecil Raj, Controller of Examinations presented the result analysis for April 2020, conducted for 2017 UG and MCA batches and 2018 P.G. batch from 21st September to 26th September, 2020. The passing board was convened on 6th October, 2020. For the remaining batch of students it was granted pass as per the instruction given by the Government. He also noted that the pass percentage in this semester is high due to Covid-19 pandemic and expressed his concern that the students have to pay more attention in the ensuing semesters.

Ph.D. Details

Dr V. Francis, Dean-School of Languages and Culture presented the details pertaining to Ph.D. Programme in the campus. During the academic year 2019-2020, 79 scholars have registered for Ph.D. programme in various departments (Full time-47 and

Part time–32). Sixty two have completed their Ph.D. in the same academic year. The overall strength of the Ph.D. scholars in the campus is 335 (Full-time – 120, Part-time – 215).

3. APPROVAL OF THE FINANCIAL EXPENDITURE

Dr S. Sahaya Sathish, Dean-School of Biological Sciences read out the details related to Receipt of UGC funds and the Approval of Autonomy Grant Budget. The college received the balance amount for the academic year 2019-2020 Rs 4,00,000/- under Autonomy Grant, Rs 80,737/- under Minor Research Projects, Rs 73,032/- under Major Research Project and Rs 15,00,000/- under Paramarsh Scheme, Grants received from other agencies from 10.01.2020 to 9.10.2020 is Rs 6,44,840/-. He also presented the proposed autonomy Grant Budget for Rs 22,00,000/- on 29th April 2020 and it was approved by the members of the committee.

Institution of Endowments / Scholarships

Rev. Fr. K. Royappan SJ, Treasurer, read out the details connected with the institution of Endowments / scholarships and the details of scholarships received by the students. Eight Endowments were instituted from 11.01.2020 to 09. 10. 2020 to the tune of Rs 4, 65,000/-.

4. APPROVAL OF MATTERS RELATING TO ADMINISTRATION AND GENERAL INTEREST

Rev. Dr S. Peter SJ presented the list of new appointments and the legal proceedings. He began his presentation with the introduction of the newly appointed administrators, HoDs, Coordinators and Directors. Sixteen unaided teaching staff were appointed this year. He also informed that the case relating to the approval of the teaching staff appointed in 2019 has been filed in the Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court.

Dr N. Ravi, Staff representative read out the various committees and its members for the approval of the Governing Body. He informed that only a few changes were carried out in accordance with the new appointments. It was approved by the Governing Body.

Report of MBA- JIM

The report of MBA – JIM was read out by Rev Dr V Joseph Xavier SJ. He assumed the office as the executive director of JIM on 3rd June 2020. The academic year officially

began on 10th August 2020. The seniors had their classes from July. The faculty members were given enough training to handle online classes. Initially the classes were held through Google classroom, later it was changed to Talent LMS. Faculty use board to teach so that the students get the feel of the classroom learning. The 2020-2022 batch students were admitted following AICTE/UGC admission norms and the online classes for the first year students began on 2nd September, 2020. Three new teaching staff were appointed on that year.

5. NEW INITIATIVES/ RECENT HAPPENINGS

Rev. Dr M. Arockiasamy Xavier SJ Principal listed out the new initiatives and the recent happenings in the campus. The IQAC has initiated the venture of developing a Learning Management System (LMS). Three new programmes were started during the academic year (B. Com. (Honours), M.A. Counselling Psychology and M. Sc. Data Science. One each additional sections in B. Sc. Computer Science and B. Com were started in Shift-II. St. Joseph's College was ranked 31st in the nation in NIRF Ranking and India Today ranked our college 57th, 46th, 80th, 55th and 39th in the Arts, Science, Commerce, BBA and BCA respectively. A good number of webinars were organized by IQAC and other departments. The college has decided to introduce UGC recommended LOCF from the ensuing syllabus revision. As per the instruction of the Higher Education Department of Government of Tamil Nadu, the college started online teaching from 3rd August 2020. Five self financing PG courses – M. A. History, M. A. HRM, M. A. Tamil, M. Sc. Electronics and M. Sc. Information Technology were suspended from this academic year as per the decision of the management. The college is taking initiative to become university. The Union Ministry of Education has recognized St. Joseph's College, as member, National Rural Entrepreneurship Mission. Rev. Fr Principal informed that the admission for the academic year 2020- 2021 was good as usual and it will be closed for first UG on 15th October, 2020 and for first PG on 31st October, 2020.

Dr A. Megala, Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education, Tiruchirappalli made a correction on the last date of admission. She informed that the Government of Tamil Nadu has extended the last date of admission to I UG and I PG till the end of October, 2020.

Dr S. Sahaya Sathish requested the Principal to include Mushroom Cultivation and Marketing (a skill-based Diploma Course under National Skills Qualification Framework- NSQF) under the new programmes started during the academic year 2020-2021 and Rev. Dr Principal agreed to add the same.

6. ALUMNI/AE ASSOCIATION

Rev. Dr S. Peter, SJ, Director of Alumni/ae Association informed about the activities which were carried by the Alumni/ae Association of St. Joseph's College. The Ninth Jesuit Alumni National Congress was held at St. Joseph's College from 17th to 19th January, 2020. Dodransbicentennial Jubilee Souvenir was released on 5th September, 2020. Rev. Dr S. Peter, SJ took charge of the Alumni Directorship on 5th September, 2020. The Alumni/ae Association has decided to revive its American Chapter soon.

Any Other Matter

Mr. C. Selvam, Business Leader, Associate Vice President, KPIT Technologies, Pune asked the college to offer embedded C program to the students as 40 to 60 hours course and also suggested that exposing the students to MATLAB will increase the percentage of absorption in industries.

Rev. Dr D. Thomas Alexander SJ wanted to know whether Ph.D. Scholars are involved in handling classes. Dr G. John, Dean-School of Management Sciences responded that already there is a practice in the Department that the Ph. D. Scholars are asked to handle classes as an alternative staff. Rev Fr Principal informed that it is not mandatory for the Ph. D. scholars to handle classes, rather their help could be used for handling remedial classes. Rev. Dr L. John Peter Arulanandham SJ suggested that an orientation can be given to research scholars if they are permitted to handle classes. Dr V. Alex Ramani appreciated the involvement of M. Phil and Ph. D. scholars as scribes for the physically challenged students.

Rev. Fr. Principal informed that an amount of Rs.22 lakhs was requested as Autonomy grant from the UGC and he opined that the UGC may not release any grant for the current academic year and the management has to bear it.

Prof. P.P. Mathur (UGC Representative) insisted that a paper on ethics has to be prescribed for all the Ph.D. research scholars, in order to avoid unethical research practices.

Rev. Dr S. Peter SJ Secretary, was of the opinion that a little more attention has to be taken in monitoring the online classes. He expressed his unhappiness over a few staff who handle the classes in Tamil. Dr S. Alfred Cecil Raj asked the IQAC to initiate a feedback survey on the conduct of online classes. Dr A. Rose Venis, Dean-IQAC replied that such an initiative has already been in the card and will be put to effect at the earliest.

Rev. Dr D Thomas Alexander SJ appreciated the college management for ensuring admission to the rural students; for the effective conduct of online classes and for organizing a good number of webinars. He was interested to know the status of admission for the newly started courses – B. Com (Honours), MA Counselling Psychology and M. Sc. Data Science. Rev. Fr. Principal replied that the response was good in all the new courses, except M.A. Counselling Psychology.

Dr N. Ravi inquired whether vacancies created by the retiring staff are being filled regularly. Rev. Fr. Secretary replied that the management is waiting for further communication from the government.

Dr V. Alex Ramani, the Deputy Principal proposed the vote of thanks.

II. MINUTES OF THE 45th ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 30th JUNE 2021

The 45th Academic Council Meeting, that was held on 30th June, 2021 virtually in Zoom platform at 10 am, began with invoking the blessings of God. Rev. Fr. Principal, Chairman of the Academic Council Meeting welcomed the members. In a special way, he welcomed the new members and thanked the outgoing members of the 44th ACM. He highlighted the process of preparation of LOCF based syllabus, as proposed by UGC.

Agenda: 1 - Passing of the minutes of the previous Academic Council meeting held on 5th August, 2020

As the first item of the agenda, Fr. Principal invited Dr. G. John, Dean-School of Management Studies to present the minutes of 44th Academic Council held on 5th August, 2020 which was ratified by the members. This was followed by a brief narration of LOCF initiatives undertaken by the college. Dr. Y. Dominic- Dean - School of Computing Sciences, explained the year long process that went into preparation of Learning Outcome based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) syllabus. This was followed by presentation of minutes of Board of Studies-School wise, for the year 2020-21.

Agenda :2 - Passing of the minutes of various Boards of Studies for the year (2020–21)

All the Departments, besides presenting the minutes of their respective boards, presented the newly framed LOCF based syllabus, course pattern and course structure.

School of Biological Sciences

Prof. T. Antony Diwakar Chandran, Head of the Department of Bio-Chemistry presented the minutes of the Department of Bio-Chemistry. Followed by Dr. A. Edward, Head of the Department of Biotechnology presented the minutes of his department. The Minutes of the Department of Botany was presented by Dr. S. R. Senthilkumar, HoD of the Botany. The minutes of School of Biological Sciences were approved by the members.

School of Computing Sciences

Minutes of the Department of Computer Science was presented by its Head, Prof. A. Charles followed by Dr. Priya Stella Mary who presented the minutes of Department of Data Science. Dr. P. Joseph Charles, Head of the Department of Information Technology presented the minutes of his Department, followed by Dr. M. Thiagarajan who presented the minutes of Department of Mathematics. Dr. Lilly George, Head of the Department of Statistics, presented the minutes of Statistics Department.

Dr. S. Sahaya Sathish, Dean-School of Biological Sciences, suggested to have uniformity with respect to writing of PSOs, the minutes of various Departments belonging to the School of Computing Sciences were approved by the members.

School of Languages and Culture

Fr. Principal called upon the Heads of School of Languages and Culture to present the minutes of BoS of the respective Departments. Dr V.L. Jayapaul, Head, Department of English presented the minutes of his Department, followed by Prof. M. Mohanalakshmi, Head of the Department of French who presented the minutes of her Department. Minutes of Department of Hindi was presented by its Head Dr. S. Sreedevi, while that of Department of History was presented by Dr. Lingammal. Dr. M.S. Madhavachari, being the Head of the Department of Sanskrit, presented the minutes of BoS of his Department and Dr. G. Beschi, the Head, Tamil Department, presented the minutes of his Department.

Fr. Principal, Dr. G. John, Dr. I. Arul Rayappan, and Dr.F.R. Alexander Pravin Durai appreciated the Department of Tamil, for its innovative move in designing School specific customized General Tamil papers (SLC-தொடர்மியல் தமிழ், SBS, SCS, SPS-அறிவியல் தமிழ், SMS-வணிகத்தமிழ்) instead of a common general Tamil paper during the 4th semester. Fr. Principal opined that the Department of Tamil could explore the similar possibility of introducing customized General Tamil Paper-III also.

With these observations, the minutes of various Departments belonging to the School of Languages and Culture were approved by the Academic Council.

School of Management Studies

Head of the Department of BBA, Prof. C.F.Octovia Antony Sessammal, presented the minutes of her Department. Minutes of Commerce and B.Com (Honours) were presented to the house by the Head of the Department of Commerce, Dr. F.R. Alexander Pravin Durai. Then it was the turn of Dr. J. Rajees, Head of the Department of Commerce - Computer Application, to present the minutes of his Department. Dr. G. Iruthayaraj, Head Department of Economics, presented the minutes of Department of Economics. Minutes of Human Resource Management was presented by its Head, Dr. J. Wilfred Angello Gerald.

During the intervention, Prof. A. Charles drew attention of the Academic council stating that all the DSE papers are Commerce related, in case of Department of Commerce - Computer Application, to which Dr. J. Rajees replied that he would ensure 60:40 ratio between commerce and Computer Science. Dr. S. Sahaya Sathish pointed out that certain words should be spelt properly and Dr. Y. Dominic pointed out that no choice of paper has been nominated in Discipline Specific Elective (DSE). Dr. J. Rajees assured that the lacuna will be rectified. After these interventions and queries, minutes of various BoS of School of Management Studies were approved by the members.

School of Physical Sciences

Dr. S. Joseph Selvaraj, Head of the Department of Chemistry presented the minutes of his department. Following him Dr. B. Kanickairaj, Head of the Department of Electronics, presented the minutes of his Department. Head of the Department of Physics, Dr. I. Arulrayappan, presented the minutes of his Department which was followed by interventions by the members of the Academic Council.

Dr. V. Alex Ramani stated that titles of certain courses of Chemistry Department could be more specific, rather than being very generic in nomenclature. Replying to the query Dr. S. Joseph Selvaraj assured that it will be taken care of Prof. A. Charles pointed out that AEC course title is missing in course structure of Physics Department. With this, the minutes of various Departments belonging to School of Physical Sciences were approved by the Academic Council members. After the Minutes of various Schools were over, minutes of other Departments were taken up for presentation and approval by the house.

Dr. S. Tamilarasi, Head in-charge, presented the minutes of Department of Visual Communication and B.Voc-Visual Communication Technology. Minutes of B.Voc Software Development and System Administration was presented by its Coordinator Dr. George Gabriel Richard Roy. This was followed by Dr. Jaga Patrick who presented the minutes of Department of Management Studies (JIM).

This was followed by intervention by the members of the Academic Council. Prof. A. Charles stated that it is inappropriate to have the course title 'Data Science using Python' to which Dr. Jaga Patrick informed that the correct nomenclature used is 'Machine Learning using Python'. Dr. F.R. Alexander Pravin Durai sought rationale for using the title Fraud Analytics. Dr. Jaga Patrick justified the use of the title with reason. Both the points were accepted by the house. Eventually, the minutes were approved by the Academic Council.

Agenda 3: Ratification

As the next agenda, ratification on academic matters for the year 2020-21 was taken up. Dr. A.N. Paul Angelo, Dean-School of Physical Sciences placed the following ratification for approval before the house.

- a) MCA syllabus was restructured so as to accommodate it, to two-year programme
- b) MA Counselling Psychology syllabus 2020
- c) M.Sc Data Science Syllabus 2020
- d) Syllabus reduction of 20 percent during the odd semester of the academic year 2020-21 in compliance with UGC guidelines
- e) CIA components and Question paper pattern, both for odd and even semester that was conducted online.
- f) Extra credit courses (MOOC) : For courses other than NPTEL and SWAYAM a new format has been formulated based on the number of hours and number of weeks involved, by the deans and it has been approved by the Chairman

IV. REPORT OF THE MBA (JOSEPH'S INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT)

Report of the Academic Year - 2021-2022

The faculty got back to work after summer holidays for a two-day faculty retreat. The retreat was primarily to reflect on the past and also to plan broadly for the academic year 2021-2022. Please be noted that the admission for the batch of 2021-2023 began in January based on the admission process already designed. As decided, the admission process was done in the months of April, May and June.

Soon after the admission process was over in June, the selected students were tutored through online mode on the basics of Accounting, Mathematics and Statistics as students come from diverse backgrounds. Apart from these courses, the students also underwent a course on communicative competence. There was an evaluation of the above courses and remedial action taken.

Courses for the second years also started on the same date as first years. The faculty geared themselves for yet another online teaching challenge and were motivated to go slow, laying greater emphasis on areas which merited in the long run. Periodical tests were conducted to find out students progress and immediately addressed. A model mid- review assessment was conceived; the students were tested on the concepts through application questions, which was well taken by the students.

In line with the St. Ignatius' novena series conducted every year, this year we conducted the same for a period of 9 days before the feast day of St. Ignatius of Loyola. The highlight of this year was the participation of JIM Alumni and the first- and second-year students as a team.

After a long gap, the first-year students got back into JIM on September 6. A parent teacher meeting was also conducted on the same day. Offline classes started with full enthusiasm from September 7 and with heightened seriousness every other day. The second-year students were placed in different industrial and commercial establishments as part of their summer internships, with all of them reported to work from September 6. They started to work on It is to be noted here that they were unable to do their summer internship programme in the months of April and May due to Covid. Online and offline guest lectures are conducted in a variety of areas; ranging from health to wellness to domain specific areas. CII- Yuva – an industrial association encouraging entrepreneurship got into action with the installation of student representatives. FDP (Faculty Development Programmes) and MDP (Management Development Programmes) are being planned for the coming months.

High Scores In Class XII, Better Rate Of Campus Placements, Low Fees Reasons More applications for engineering counselling are expected this year

The Covid-19 pandemic continues, but engineering colleges are hoping for a better admission season. Better campus placements, increase in pass percentage of Class XII students and several fold increase in top scorers and low fees for government quota seats will result in more applications for counselling, experts said.

Of the 6.16 lakh registered for the Class XII state board exams, 2.02 lakh, or around one in every four students, scored above 500 marks. The number of students scoring above 551 marks rose by 15 times over last year.

As per the schedule released by Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions (TNEA) on Sunday, students can apply for BE, B Tech for 2021-22 at www.tneanline.org from July 26

to August 24. The rank list will be out on September 4 and counselling will be held online from September 7 to October 20.

P Selvaraj, secretary of the Consortium of Self-Financing Professional, Arts and Science Colleges in Tamil Nadu, said more applications or engineering counselling were expected this year. Of the 1.31 lakh applicants last year, 1.12 lakh took part. Due to high Class XII scores, more students are hopeful of getting seats. The other reason would be the less fee for government quota seats," he added.

Arts & science colleges to launch online application window from today

Colleges in Chennai are planning to launch online applications for admissions to arts and science courses for the 2021-22 academic year from Monday.

While most colleges are mulling online applications, some colleges which have already opened online registrations are now planning to allow students to update their Class XII marks.

Rithira College for Women principal S Kothai said her college will issue online applications to fill up 2,450 seats, and that the admission process will be completely online this year.

DG Vaishnav College in Arumbakkam has received more than 30,000 online registrations for 3,000 seats for this academic year. "Before admissions, we will allow Class XII state board students to upload their marks with their applications, CBSE Class XII results are expected on July 28. After the results, CBSE students will be given two or three days to upload marks," said S Santhosh Baboo, principal of DG Vaishnav College.

The Directorate of collegiate education on Sunday announced that students can register online for 1.06 lakh seats in 143 government arts and science colleges from July 26 to August 18. They can register their online applications at www.tngasa.org, www.tngasa.in.

Tamil Nadu Government Collegiate Teachers Association (TNGCTA) president T Veeramani urged the government to speed up the admission process for government arts and science colleges.

"The higher education department can give up to one week for CBSE students to upload their marks after the results and wind up the admission process. If the admission process is further delayed, students will join private colleges," he said.

year. "They prefer seats for their wards through counselling as many of them may not be able to pay the management quota fees. Only top colleges are able to fill management quota seats." While the fee for government quota seats is ₹50,000 (₹55,000 for accredited courses), management quota fee is ₹87,000. Around 20 private colleges got their management quota fees revised to ₹1.2 lakh.

"Due to more than 50% vacancies in the last few years, parents are waiting for engineering counselling to get admissions. So far, management

quota admissions have been relatively better compared to previous year," said B Chidambaram, principal of SRM Valluvar Engineering College in Chennai. Some may opt for management quota seats later, he added.

R M Kishore, vice-chairman of RMK Engineering College, said top colleges were likely to fill all seats. "We are expecting tough competition for top 50 colleges and a significant rise in cut-off marks particularly for computer science engineering, IT, AI and data science, AI and machine learning," he said.

No single window system for arts and science colleges admission this yr too

State Govt Has No Plan To Introduce It

Trichy: Arts and science colleges in the state will admit students by individually conducting admission this year as there are no plans from the state government to introduce the much-needed single window system for college admissions.

The single window system is in place for medical and engineering colleges. But arts and science colleges in the state make admissions independently by inviting applications to various undergraduate and postgraduate courses.

Educationalists point out that aided arts and science colleges manipulate the availability of seats to various courses to mint money. Further, students too are put to hardship by not getting suitable courses based on their marks in colleges of their choice in the absence of a centralised system.

"The state government is considering the option of introducing the single window system of admission in 106 government arts and science colleges this year. But it should have been ideally introduced in aided and self-financing arts and science colleges," said T. Nedunchezhiyan, a retired Tamil professor.

PAVING WAY FOR IRREGULARITIES

Single window admission system is a process through which students completing Class XII apply and gain admission to colleges based on their marks.

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Director of collegiate education, which governs arts and science colleges in the state, had sought opinion from the colleges three years ago on the same following public demand, but there wasn't any progress.

"When neighbouring states such as Kerala and Andhra Pradesh could successfully implement SWS for arts and science colleges, Tamil Nadu should implement it considering the welfare of students," said MDMK state youth wing secretary V. Ravanan.

"Close to three lakh students join these colleges every year. Colleges have been earning a huge sum by selling applications. Colleges should scrutinise all the applications received from students before admitting them. But colleges are indulging in first come first serve basis to prevent students from considering other options. Students are put to stress in selecting a college of their convenience if they receive calls from more than one college," he said.

"Without making an amendment to the rule number 9 (3) of the Tamil Nadu Private College Regulations Act 1976 - which says admission of the students is the exclusive responsibility of the college principal - the state government cannot implement the single window system," said president of AUT K. Pandiyan. Pandiyan also insisted on determining the fee structure of the courses offered by aided and self-financing colleges.

As he recently received his sixth semester marks a few days back he updated the online application on Tuesday. He received a call from the college saying that he got a seat and an office staff asked Rajesh to pay the first semester fee of ₹25500 through UPI payment gateway to confirm the seat. "It was unlikely to be a fake call as the office staff read out all the credentials that I had submitted online including the application number," said Rajesh.

Two air pollution monitoring stations go live

Air quality monitoring machines installed in St Joseph College, Bharathidasan University among 28 places in TN

CHIEF Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami on Wednesday commissioned air quality monitoring stations established at 28 places across the State, including St Joseph College and Bharathidasan University premises, through video conference from Chennai.

The systems installed will monitor air quality and share the data with Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCB). Though TNPCB installed the system in St Joseph College in January last, the inauguration was delayed.

The project is the brainchild of former Chief Minister J Jayalalithaa who, in 2015, announced that air quality monitoring systems would be installed in 25 places. The current government has established it in about 28 locations.

"It is a welcome initiative by the government. We are glad that they selected our college for setting up the facility. We are already conducting several initiatives to enhance the knowledge of our students

about the environment. Since we are having the access to the air pollution data, we hope that it would further help our students to have better understanding of pollution levels and the need to protect our environ-

ment," said Dr M Arockiasamy Xavier, Principal, St Joseph College.

Sources said the stations can assess the quality of air in a five-kilometre radius. The centre at St Joseph College would

give the pollution level in Chathiram bus stand and Rockfort. The systems will give real-time information of particulate (PM 2.5, 10) and other pollutants (Sulphur Dioxide, Ammonia, Carbon Monoxide, etc.). The information would be displayed for the public at the entrance of the two institutions.

"Officials should install some board in Tamil near display system. Then, the information would be more noticeable for the public," said T Arivalagan, a resident.

Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami on Wednesday commissioned Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board's Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station (CAAQMS) at Bharathidasan University and St. Joseph's College.

The facility, each costing ₹2 crore, was started at 25 locations across the State. The data from the stations would enable government agencies to keep the general public informed about the current level of air pollution, and formulate strategies, policies and decisions, besides generating knowledge on the long-term and short-term implications on public health.

The establishment of ambient air quality station provided direction for management of air quality, maintenance of ecological safety and conservation, and

creation of sustainable environment for human society and nature, officials said.

The station was inaugurated at Bharathidasan University in the presence of Vice-Chancellor P. Manisankar, Registrar G. Gopinath, Joint Chief Environmental Engineer K. Elankumaran, District Environmental Engineer R. Lakshmi and other

senior officials.

The establishment of CAAQMS was a sequel to the memorandum of understanding signed by the university's Department of Environmental Biotechnology with TNPCB.

According to officials, all parameters of air quality such as sulfur dioxide, carbon monoxide, ozone molecule, gaseous ammonia, nitric oxide, nitrogen dioxide, BTX - Benzene, Toluene, Xylene, and meteorological parameters - rainfall, solar radiation, wind direction, wind speed, temperature and humidity - would be monitored continuously by TNPCB and Indian Institute of Technology-Madras.

The data from the station could be used by scientists, academicians and students for teaching and research purpose, the Vice-Chancellor said.

Featuring measuring instruments and display units,

the CAAQMS facility at St. Joseph's College had been made useful to the public through installation of LCD board for projection of real-time data.

The facility envisaged tracking air quality in various places, including residential localities, industrial sites, commercial locations and roadside areas to a five-km distance in the surroundings, College Principal Rev. Fr. M. Arockiasamy Xavier said.

Monitoring helped in assessing the level of pollution in relation to the ambient air quality standards, and set the target for pollution reduction. The college would conduct awareness programmes at the local level for students and the general public of the importance of environment and health and secure projects from national agencies for broad-basing efforts for pollution control, he said.
