#### 7. CoE's Presentation report in the Governing Body

Result Analysis was carried out and presented in the Governing Body for approval of ODD Semester on 16.03,2022.

All the Question papers for UG, PG, and M.Phil. were given to the Librarian after the Semester Examinations, in the form of Soft and Hard copy.

#### 8. New initiatives

The e-governance of examination modules facilitated the following which includes CIA and Semester Examinations (SE):

- > Online distribution of Question Papers without system encryption in Google Exam Room for SEs.
- ➤ The digitalisation of the Answer Scripts
- > On-Screen evaluation of the Answer Scripts
- > Transparency in various activities by the faculty concerned
- > Information retrieval mechanism
- > Automation at the office of the Controller of Examinations (sending the Appointment Orders for Semester Examinations, evaluations, receiving Question Papers, etc.)

#### **Online Examinations and Evaluation**

The success of online examinations and evaluation depends on the coordinated efforts of the Office of Controller of Examinations, Faculty members' consistent understanding and support, and Students' understanding of and response to all the instructions.

➤ This year, ODD semester (August 2021 to February 2022) conducted in online mode without end semester test. While EVEN semester (March 2022 to June 2022) is conducted in offline mode (Regular classes and examinations) for all UG & PG programmes. M.Phil. programmes (by 3 departments) have been decentralised to conduct and evaluate the courses by themselves but coordinated by the Office of the Controller of Examinations.

- ➤ During ODD Semester Examinations (SE) was conducted through Google Exam Rooms (GERs) prepared application software such that writing, invigilation and valuation were done through different but related dashboards
- > For courses adopting MCQ patterns, four different combinations of question papers were sent at random to the students
- ➤ The Project and Internship *viva-voce* were conducted in the regular mode and the PPTs were collected as evidence by the Office of the Controller of Examinations.
- ➤ The EVEN semester results were published in 9 working days, while odd semester results were declared in 21 days time.
