Formula for Cumulative Grade Point Average

$$\text{Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)} = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^n C_i GP_i}{\sum_{i=1}^n C_i}$$

C_i - is the credits assigned to the course

GP_i - is the grade point corresponding to the grade obtained for each course

n - is the number of all courses successfully cleared during all the Semesters
