



**RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

1. Reference is made to your registration for Management Aptitude Test (MAT) FEB 2022.
2. You are permitted to appear for Computer Based Test as per the schedule given on Page 1. You must carry this Admit Card to the Test Centre for appearing in the Test.
3. This admit card is valid only for the test date and time as specified on Page 1. Any request for change of test date or test centre will not be entertained.
4. You must reach the test Centre preferably before the Reporting Time indicated on Page 1 and, in any case, well before the Test Centre Gate Closing Time. Once the test centre gate is closed, you will not be permitted entry under any circumstances.
5. You must bring any valid original Photo ID proof such as (i) Voter ID Card (ii) PAN Card, (iii) Driving License, (iv) Aadhaar Card, (v) Passport, (vi) Photo ID card issued by any govt. dept., (vii) Photo ID card issued by any recognized educational institution, etc. to the test centre for verification. Otherwise you will not be permitted for the test.
6. You must bring filled in COVID related Self-Declaration along with Admit Card to be permitted for the test.
7. You must bring Ball Point Pen (black/blue) for taking the test.
8. The items listed below are strictly NOT allowed inside the test centre:
  - a. Mobile Phone, digital/smart watch, Bag, Handbag, Papers, notes, books, calculator, electronic gadgets/ equipment's, correction marker/white fluid, any other suspicious item/material, etc.
  - b. It is clarified that there shall be no arrangements at Test Centres for keeping the aforesaid items. If any item is lost, the Centre or AIMA will not be responsible. Candidates are, therefore, advised either not to carry the aforementioned items with them on the date of the test or to make their own arrangements for keeping such items in safe custody outside the Test Centre at their sole risk.
  - c. Any candidate found using or in possession of such unauthorized material or indulging in copying or adopting unfair means is liable to be summarily disqualified.
9. Blank paper sheets for rough work will be provided in the examination Hall/Lab and will be collected back by invigilator.
10. The question paper will have 200 Objective Type Questions. Duration of the Paper will be 150 minutes. There will be 25% negative marking for wrong and/or incorrectly marked answers.
11. Candidates are NOT required to provide their personal particulars like Mobile No, Email Id, Address, etc. to anybody inside or outside the test center.
12. Candidates belonging to "Persons with Disability" category and have mentioned in the application form that their disability is such that it causes limitation in writing and have opted for scribe, would be granted the use/facility of scribe and compensatory time of 50 minutes (@ 20 minutes per hour of test subject) to their producing a proper Certificate from the competent authority.
13. Any attempt to influence the test or malpractice will lead to disqualification of your candidature.
14. On completion of a shift, the candidates will be permitted to move out in an orderly manner one candidate at a time. Please wait for instructions from invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised.

**INFORMATION ON COMPUTER BASED TEST (CBT)**

- The questions will appear in English.
- Every question is followed by 4 answer options. Choose the option that is most appropriate. Indicate your answer by clicking on the circle/box adjacent to the option you think is right.
- You can go to any question directly by clicking on the question number. The answered question number and the unanswered/ skipped question number will appear in different colours.
- If you are doubtful of the answer, you can mark a question for review. This will be unmarked automatically, once you come back to the same question at a later time.
- If you want to change your answer to any question, you may select the question and change the answer by clicking on the appropriate answer.
- There will be 25% negative marking for wrong answers.
- Timer display at the top of the screen indicates the time throughout the test.
- You can move between sections at your will.
- The test closes automatically once the allotted time of 150 Minutes is over.
- In case you finish your test before allotted time, you will get a confirmation page which will give you two options. Either to go back to the test or to complete the test.
- In case you want to review the answers in the remaining time you can do so, else, you may complete the test and submit.
- Ensure that you click on submit as a sign of completion. Please be sure before clicking 'submit' that you have completed the test. Once you submit, you will not be able to go back to the test.






