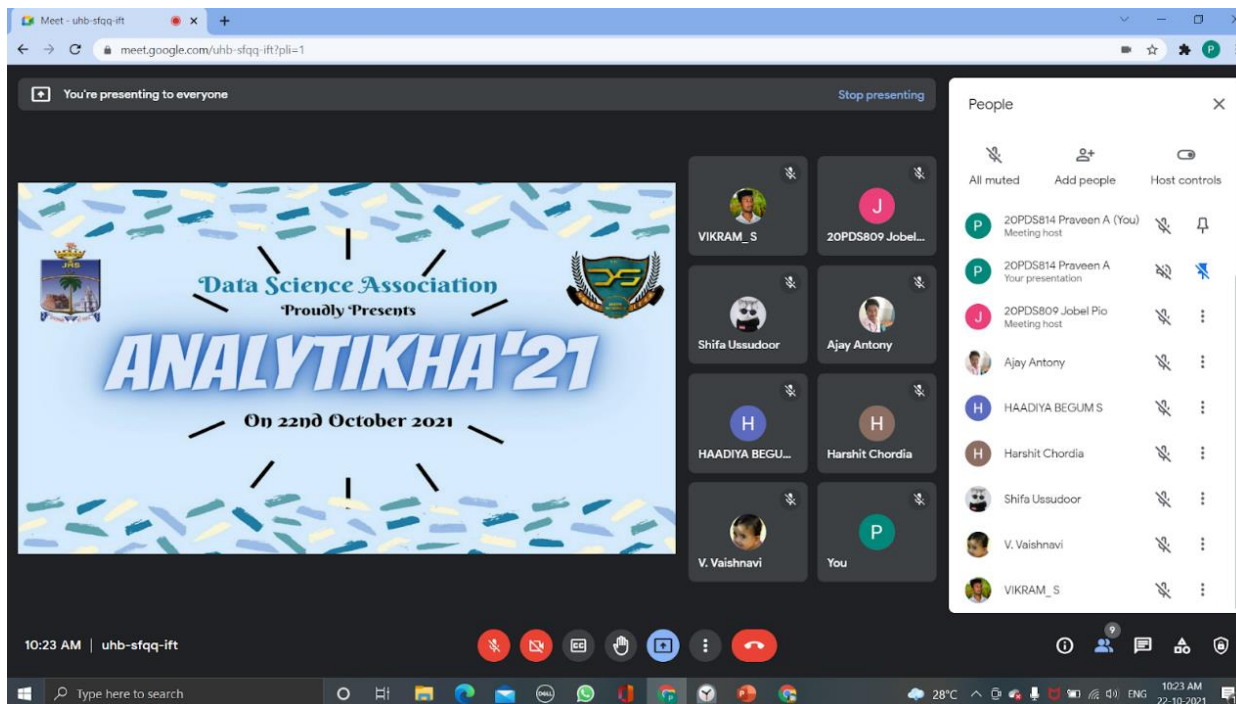


Image 1: Poster of “ANALYTIKHA’21” competition being presented

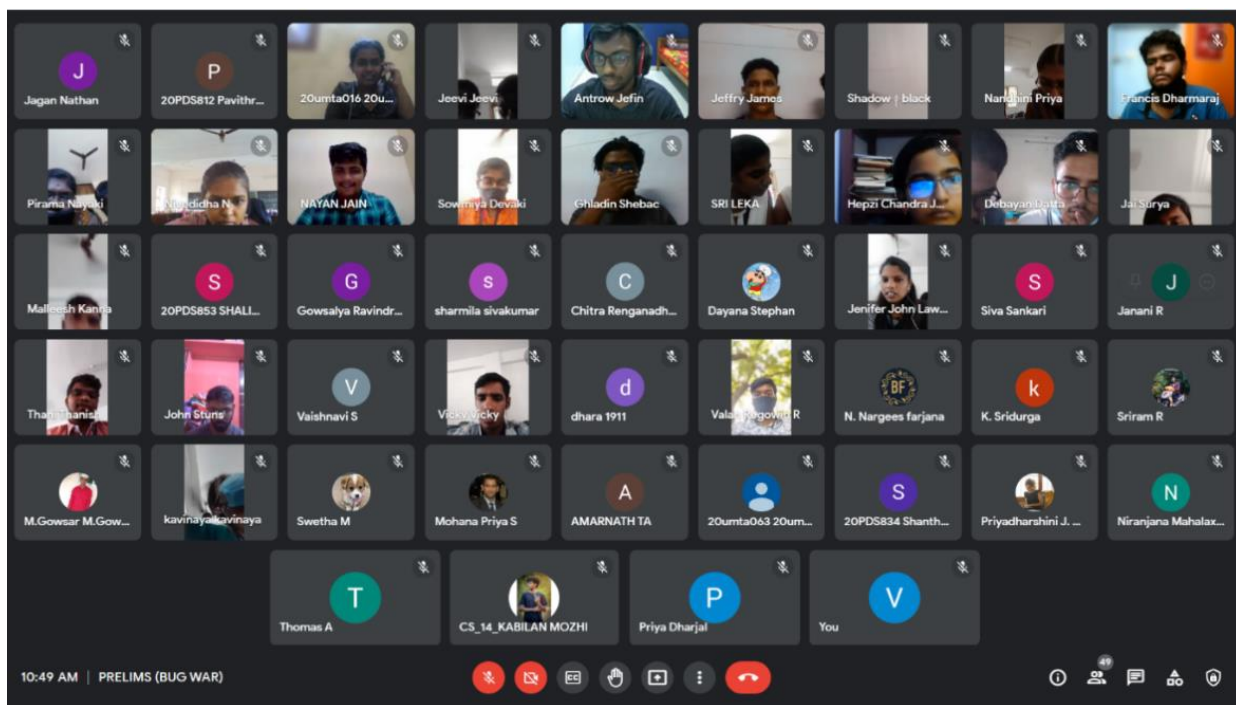


Image 2: Participants of “ANALYTIKHA’21” competition

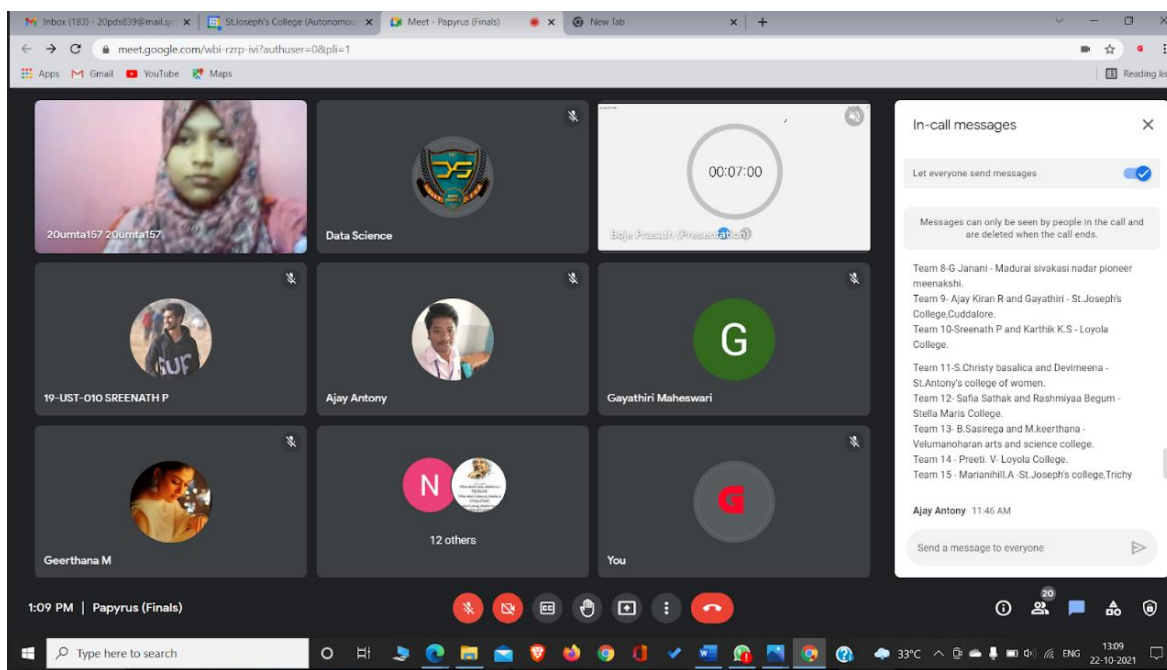


Image 3: Finals of the Competition “Papyrus” being held

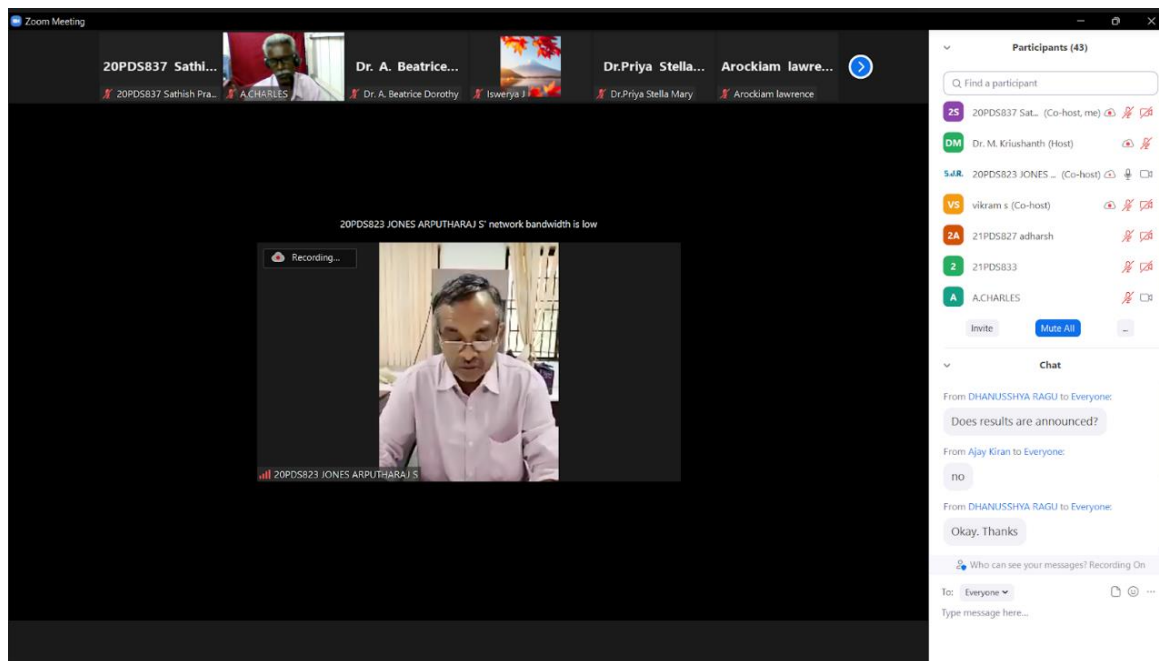


Image 4: Dr. L. Arockiam, Head, Department of Data Science addressing the gathering
