INDEP-2022

The signature event of St. Joseph's College, INDEP -2022 was held between May 13 and 14, 2022. However, the off stage events were commenced from May 09, 2022 at Fr. K.P. Joseph Hall. Rev. Dr. L. John Peter Arulanandam SJ began the events officially with a short prayer and felicitation.

The grand inauguration of INDEP 2022 was held on May 13, 2022 at 9.00 am in the open stage. The dignitaries were taken to the venue in a procession led by our College band. The event began with prayer song followed by invocation to Mother Tamil sung by Fine Arts Music Team. Dr. V. Alex Ramani, the Deputy Principal welcomed the gathering and introduced the chief guest. Rev. Dr. Leonard Fernando, SJ, the Rector and Rev. Dr. M. Xavier Arockiasamy, SJ, the Principal offered blessing and felicitation, respectively. Mr. Prasanth Pandiaraj, Cine director delivered the inaugural address. He emphasised that the students community should focus on their talents and competencies with great passion and inclination. Further, he stressed that the students should not be influenced by the negative comments and remarks given by others. Dr. J. Michealraj proposed the vote of thanks.



Variety of events numbering 18 (Fine Arts, Music, Dance, Theatre Arts and Literary) were conducted in different venues such as Lawley Hall, Community Centre open air and SAIL Hall for one and a half days. Experts from the respective fields were invited as judges. The administrators honoured the judges of all the events on the

main venue. Around 1500 students represented through 26 teams and exhibited their talents in all the events.

The valedictory function was held on Saturday at 11.30 am on the concluding day of INDEP - 2022 at the open stage. The Chief Guest, former IAS officer Mr. U. Sahayam, was received in Fr. Principal's office by the college administrators. The dignitaries were taken traditionally by College band in a procession to the open stage. After invocation of God's blessing by the fine arts music team, Rev. Dr. John Peter Arulanandam SJ delivered the welcome address and Dr. Vimal Jerold introduced the Chief Guest. The Chief Guest asked the students to be socially concerned and to have a compassionate heart for the less privileged, remain simple and honest forever. He called the students to love all people including farmers, weavers, fishermen, working-class, urban poor and to work for them. In his hour-long speech, he reminisced several anecdotes about how he was victimised due to his honesty at various stages of his career.
