Sir Mokshagundan Visvesvaraya
M. Visvesvaraya (1860-1962) who was an engineer and designed the Krishna Raja Sagara Dam and sponsored the Bhadravathi Iron Works. He was an admirer of Japan's industrial progress and also studied the Soviet Five Year Plans and the initiatives of the American President Roosevelt whose New Deal (it was a huge government economic intervention to revive economy that was mired in the Great Depression) showed the power of State to rebuild economies. In 1934 he published suggestions for a ten-year plan for India which was the first attempt at economic planning in India.
