Theme: Tips to boost Self Confidence

During the time of recruitment by the various companies, a couple of weaknesses that are often indicated by the placement officers of various companies coming to our college -lack of Self Confidence and inadequate communication skills. In fact, self-confidence and communication skills are interconnected. This lack of self-confidence is obviously revealed during the interviews via inadequate communication skills of our students. It is a matter of serious concern for a well reputed institution like ours. Communication skills are not only about proficiency in the language one speaks but also a matter of self-expression. In fact, communication is all about self-confidence.

1. **Individuals have intrinsic worth and dignity:** Everyone is bestowed with the ability to communicate intelligently, to contemplate a bright future, to experience freedom with responsibility. Students need to believe in their worthiness and dignified way of living.
2. **Set Goals:** Well-defined goals give a person a sense of direction, a feeling of accomplishment when someone reaches the goals. There is a sense of purpose and vision when both short term and long term goals are set. Have our students learnt to set goals?
3. **Develop language Skills:** Language skills are one of the significant traits of a Personality. Discipline is not something that you do for others but it is something that you do for those you care about. Discipline in Academics, Work, Relationships, Foods and entertainment will create only success stories. Lack of discipline will prevent people from succeeding.
6. **Practice Auto suggestions:** Students can develop positive self-talk such as I can handle it, I can do it, I am good at studies, I have a good memory
7. **Take inventory:** Help the students to make a list of their strengths and weakness. Focus on what they want to do rather than what they don't want to do.

8. **Individuals grow through love:** Down through the centuries, love has been the theme of Gurus, Teachers, poets, movies etc. In every action, add an ounce of love. Whether it is departmental activities, college activities, social activities, family activities, adding an ounce of love makes a sea of difference in the self-confidence of the individuals.
9. **Hold the Values:** There is a tendency among people to use one another as a means to achieve their ends but should be relating to one another according to Martin Buber's notion of "I and Thou". We are God's supreme creation. When we uphold the true values, we can sail confidently.





The very possession of a smart phone makes a teenager proud that he is the owner of something. It does boost the self-image and self-confidence of the students. It has a lot of advantages if smart phones are used purposefully. Technology should be used for learning, research and teaching purposes in Educational institutions. People must manage technology for creative, constructive and capacity building of the mind activities and not otherwise. I wish that most of our students manage technology well. What if technology manages people?

Some observations on the use of Cell phones by the Students of St.Joseph's College

A. Proliferation of Maladaptive behaviors

- Possession of smart phones raise many disciplinary issues in the class rooms & public places
- When phones keep ringing/even if they are in silent mode, it is a disturbance for self and others
- Using cell phones during the class, in between the class hours, messaging and viewing the message-are clear moments are distractions
- Walking with the cell phones unmindful of the presence of other fellow students, professors, elders and officials are clear indications of overuse

B. Dependent Behaviors and Lack of focus

I hear from the professors that some students don't take notes at all in the classes. Even when the professors give them time and ask the students to copy down the notes written on the black/White board, they don't listen. It can be presumed that such students with obvious easygoing and lethargic attitude may even use these materials during the examinations. Moreover, these disinterested and unmotivated students pose a challenge to the authority of the teachers and a cause of concern for interested students.

C. Impact on interpersonal living

Smart phones are meant to increase meaningful connectivity with human beings. Meaningful connectivity may not happen when there is so much of obsession only for fun and cheap jokes for which they waste much of their time, energy and money.

For example: If there are four students sitting in a place, all of them are glued to the cell phones and they are in their own world. Where is the connectivity?

D. Decline in study skills

There are umpteen educational sites available in ICT. What is the percentage of students using these educational sites?

It is unfortunate to say that most number of students don't even spend 30 minutes a day for reading, writing and studying anything at all. Reading habits of the students have taken a nose dive and dipped to the lowest level.

E. Unhealthy Physical Proximity

After the introduction of Cell phones on Campus, in the pretext of sharing, viewing, messaging and studying, the physical proximity is found to be unpleasant. Physical postures can mislead people with negative impression.

F. Non Transparent Behaviors


Usage of cell phones in campus is definitely on the rise. Students tend to become so private and secretive in their communications and relationships and they shy away from getting guidance from parents, teachers and mentors. Consequently their behaviors are non-transparent.


- Are students mature enough to use cell phones in a responsible and judicious way?




