EYE CAMP PROGRAMME ON 01.09.2024

INTRODUCTION:

We visited the kalkulathupatti village. In this village we have set up an free eye checkup camp with the help of the "Eye Foundation Trichy" hospital. AIM: The aim of setting up an eye checkup camp in a rural village is to bridge the gap in access to essential eye care services and improve the overall health of the community. Many rural areas face significant barriers to healthcare access, including limited availability of medical professionals and lack of awareness about eye health.

OBJECTIVES:

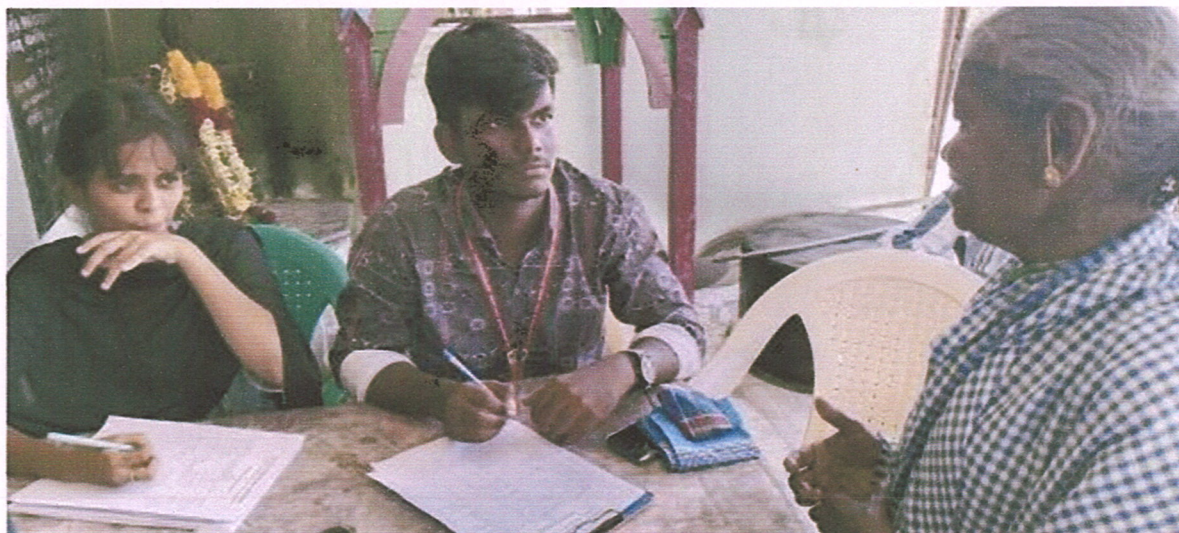
The objectives of organizing an eye camp are multi-faceted and impactful. First and foremost, the camp aims to provide comprehensive eye screenings to identify and diagnose vision problems and eye conditions early. By doing so, we ensure that individuals receive timely treatment or referrals to specialized care if needed.

ACTIVITY:

We reached around the village to make arrangements for the necessary eye camp. Announcements were made about the eye camp being conducted, and people were invited to come for the check-up. The doctors from The Eye Foundation, Trichy, arrived by 9:00 am. The camp started around 9:30 am and continued until 10:30 am. There were people from Kalkulathupatti, Idaiyapatti, and E-Mettupatti attending the camp. The crew of the camp, including several members, was available for registration. People of different age groups visited the camp and benefited from the services provided. The doctors served beverages during short breaks. Many people were advised to follow up at a hospital due to significant eye problems. Some were asked to check their vision power and use glasses. Approximately 50-60 people attended the eye check-up. The camp concluded around 2:00 pm with the wrap-up and a photo session. The doctors were thanked, and food was provided. The doctors left by 2:30 pm, and all the students and camp team departed from the village by 3:00 pm.

2ND Prize for Kathirvel M.

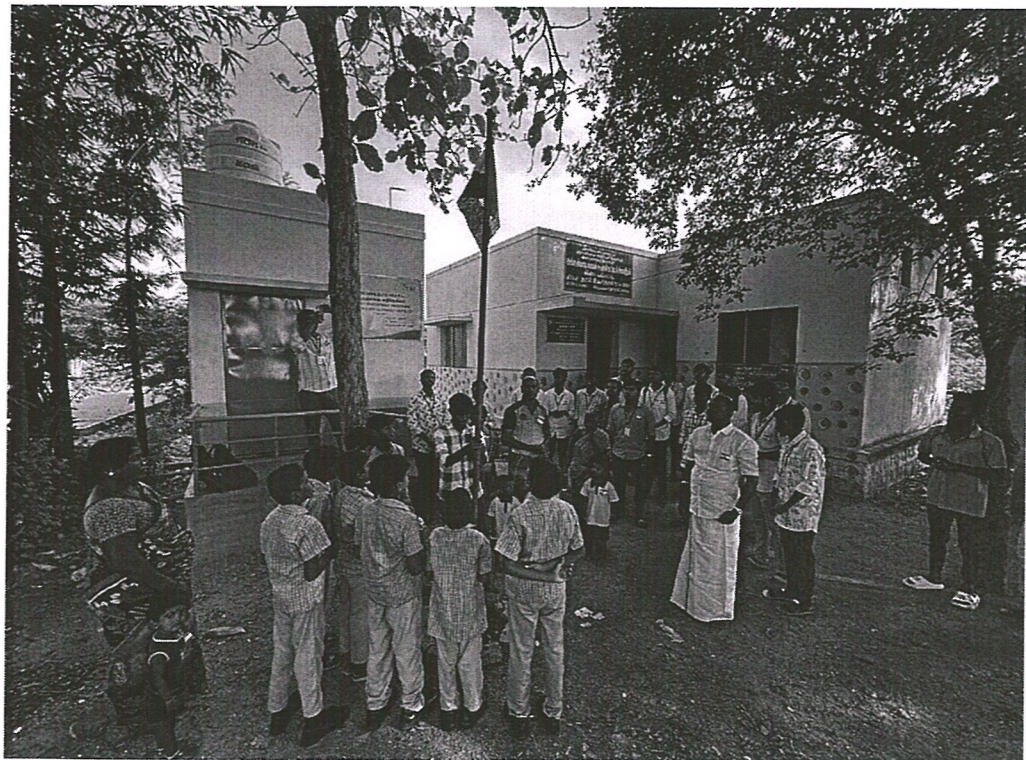

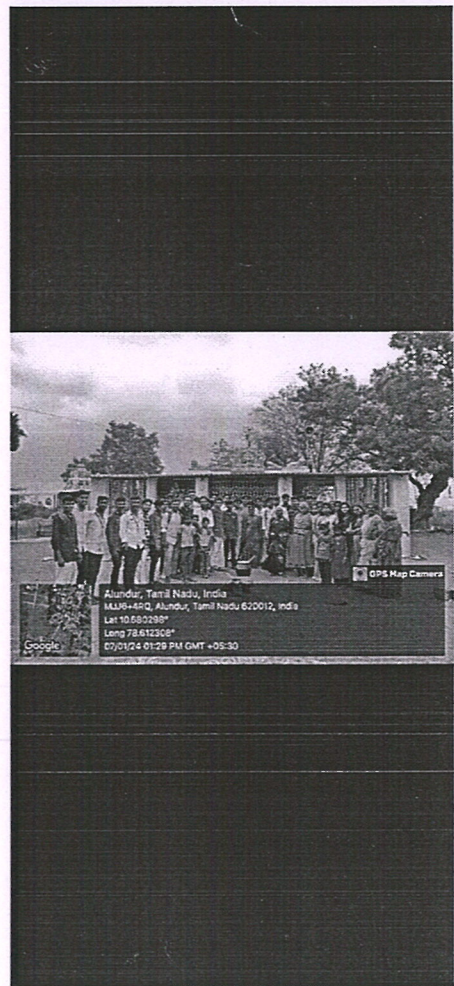
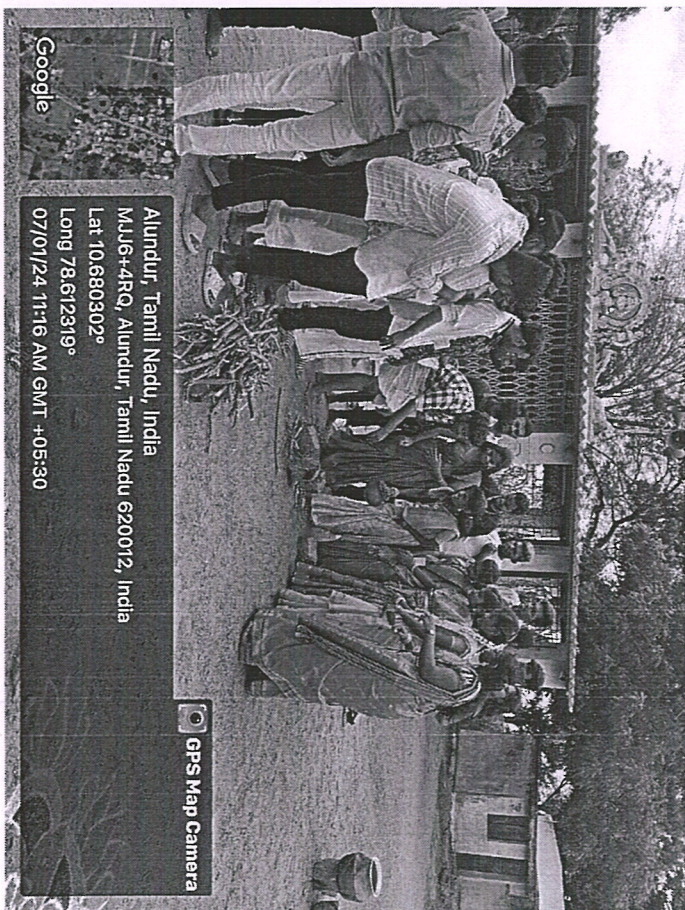
