18% of the students expressed that IDC are excellent, 48% as Good, 28% as Satisfactory, 02 % Unsatisfactory and 04% below average.

#### **Self-Paced Learning**

18% of the students expressed that Self Paced Learning courses are excellent, 47% as Good, 26% as Satisfactory, 03 % Unsatisfactory and 06% below average.

22% of the students expressed that student support service in the college are excellent 49% as Good, 19% as Satisfactory, 04 % Unsatisfactory and 06% below average.


