REPORT OF FREE MEDICAL CAMP

The MSc Botany students organized a free medical camp on February 25, 2024, in the impoverished urban area of Devadhanam. Teaming up with Trichy Child Jesus Hospital, the doctors Dr. Sr. Vijila Paulraj, Dr. Sr. Jakulin, and Dr. Sr. Paulin provided diagnoses and medicines to the patients. The camp included health checkups for BMI, blood pressure, and overall blood health. Reverend Dr. T. Sahayaraj, SJ, who gave the opening speech, graced the event. The coordination of the program was handled by Mr. S. Lenin, Senior Coordinator, Mr. Karthik, and the team of MSc Botany students. The program was presided over by Mrs. C. Thangalakshmi, Councilor, Mr. Kamaraj, Village President, and Mr. James, Urban Area Development Committee Member. In total, 220 patients were able to benefit from the medical camp.

REPORT FREE EYE CHECKUP CAMP

Eye screening camps and general medical camps were organized in rural villages and urban poor areas. The main goal of these camps was to detect individuals with various eye issues such as conjunctivitis, age-related macular degeneration, cataract, diabetic retinopathy, and glaucoma. Optometrists played a crucial role during these camps in preventing visual impairments by providing discounted glasses from reputable optical companies. A total of 436 patients tested in the camp, with 16 of them being recommended for eye surgery.

81 Students from Govt. Hr. Sec. 



Jointly Organizing a Two Days ANU Awareness Program 2023

on

Atomic Energy and its uses to the Humanity **30th Nov. & 1st Dec. 2023** Venue: St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, TamilNadu, India

Preamble

The Anu awareness program is to showcase indigenous progress in nuclear technology as a part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, which is being co-organized by the Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, and the Academy of Sciences, Chennai, on November 30 and December 1, 2023. The program is intended to create awareness about nuclear science and technology and highlight the activities of the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) among the youth, especially in the rural areas of all districts in Tamil Nadu.

The objective of the program is threefold:

- (i) The progress in nuclear science and technology in India, including nuclear power and societal application of ionizing radiation
- (ii) To create interest among the youth in science subjects and to explore the opportunities at DAE
- (iii) Dispelling myths on nuclear energy.

The awareness program will be a two-day event comprising lectures, quiz competitions, creative writing competitions, conceptual present actions, and exhibitions. It showcases nuclear reactor models and the application of ionizing radiation in medical, industrial, and agricultural fields.

About IGCAR

Indira Gandhi Centre for Atomic Research [IGCAR], the second largest establishment of the Department of Atomic Energy next to Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, was set up at Kalpakkam, in 1971 with the main objective of conducting broad based multidisciplinary programme of scientific research and advanced Engineering, directed towards the development of sodium cooled Fast Breeder Reactor [FBR] technology, in India. This is part of the second stage of Indian Atomic Energy Programme, which is aimed at preparing the country for utilization of the extensive Thorium reserves and providing means to meet the large demands of electrical energy in 21st century. In meeting the objective, a modest beginning was made by constructing sodium cooled Fast Breeder Test Reactor [FBTR], with a nominal power of 40 MWt, based on the French Reactor, RAPSODIE. The reactor attained its first criticality on 18th Oct, 1985 and has been in operation at its maximum attainable power level of 10.5 MWe with a small core. It is the first of its kind in the world to use Plutonium Uranium mixed carbide as a driver fuel. Over the years, the centre has established comprehensive R & D facilities covering the entire spectrum of FBR technology related to Sodium Technology, Reactor Engineering, Reactor Physics, Metallurgy and Materials, Chemistry of Fuels and its materials, Fuel Reprocessing, Reactor Safety, Control and Instrumentation, Computer Applications etc., and has developed a strong base in a variety of disciplines related to this advanced technology. With the experience and expertise gained by the successful operation of FBTR, the Centre has embarked upon the design and construction of 500 MWe, Prototype Fast Breeder Reactor.

A 30 KWt, U233 fueled mini reactor [KAMINI] has been made operational for neutron radiography, neutron activation analysis etc., IGCAR utilizes its expertise and resources in enhancing its standing as a leading Centre for research in various branches of basic, applied and engineering sciences that have a bearing on Nuclear Technology like Structural Mechanics, Heat and Mass Transfer, Material Science, Fabrication Processes, Non-Destructive Testing, Chemical sensors, High temperature thermodynamics, Radiation Physics, Computer science etc.,

About the Academy of Sciences (ASC)

The Academy of Sciences, Chennai, was formerly known as the Tamil Nadu Academy of Sciences since 1976. It reviews periodically the education, research, development, and application in the various branches of science in our state and honours the scientists with awards. It supports and recommends grants for organization of special courses that have relevance to the needs of the students. The Academy of Sciences Chennai is conducting the Summer Training Program (STP) in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics every year for PG students for 3 weeks. The Academy organizes or helps to organize, national and international levels seminars, workshops, and conferences at the state. Many Research institutes and Universities in Tamilnadu are the Institutional members of the Academy.

About the Institution

St. Joseph's is an autonomous college of the Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, located in the central part of Tamil Nadu, South India. ANU AWARENESS PROGRAM – 2023 – REPORT

The Department of Physics, St. Joseph's college, Tiruchirappalli, Indira Gandhi center for Atomic Research, Kalpakkam and The Academy of sciences, Chennai jointly organized a two-day ANU Awareness program- 2023 on **Atoms in the service of the Nation** at St. Joseph's college,

Tiruchirappalli on 30th Nov & 01st Dec 2023.

The ANU awareness program is to showcase indigenous progress in nuclear technology as a part of AzadikaAmritMahotsav which is an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of independence and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements. This program is intended to create awareness about nuclear science and technology and highlight the activities of the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) and career guidance among the youth, especially in the rural areas of all districts in Tamil Nadu.

The objective of the program is threefold:

(i) To showcase the progress in nuclear science and technology in India, including nuclear power and societal application of ionizing radiation.

(ii) To create interest among the youth in science subjects and to explore the opportunities at DAE.

(iii) Dispelling myths on nuclear energy.

The awareness program includes a two-day event comprising lectures, quiz competitions, creative writing competitions, slogan writing and exhibitions. It showcases nuclear reactor models and the application of ionizing radiation in medical, industrial, and agricultural fields. **DAY 1 – 30th November**

The event was inaugurated on 30.11.23 at 9.30 AM with a prayer song. Dr. I Johnson, Head and Associate Professor, Dept. of Physics, St. Joseph's College welcomed the gathering. He talked about the association of IGCAR with St. Joseph's college. The felicitations were given by Rev. Dr. K AMAL SJ, Secretary, St. Joseph's College & Rev. Dr. M. Arockiasamy Xavier SJ, Principal, St. Joseph's College. Prof. Dr. B.Venkatraman, Director, IGCAR, Kalpakkam delivered the Presidential address. In his presidential address he started by wishing the college management. He thanked Dr Stephan, Secretary ASC, for initiating this awareness program. ASC plays a vital role in popularizing the basic science at University level. The IGCAR Centre primarily focuses on sodium cooled fast reactor and associated fuel cycle technologies. They also extended their arm in deploying various spin of technologies for societal applications and to create awareness on the need for nuclear power. Worldwide they are relying on nuclear power which is green and clean energy source. Even UAE which has large oil resource is getting ready with four nuclear power plant with 1000 MW power capacity each. So there should be greater awareness on nuclear power for two reasons. One is the effect and other is the various opportunities in the field. He mentioned about the role of nuclear energy in agriculture, food products to processing of food, to defense, transport, heritage and how atoms severed mankind in variety of ways and how radiation plays a vital role.

IGCAR is the UGC DAE nodal centre which can be used by research scholars, faculty and student to pursue Ph.D and research projects. So, he earnestly requested all the constitutes/colleges to visit regularly. The students from chemistry, biology and physics can do their projects at IGCAR.

The Director further explained that starting salary for Class I officer is about Rs.70, 000/and many privileges like medical facilities, schools and accommodations are included.

Director asked the colleges to offer many elective courses in the latest fields which may create job opportunities So all these can be done in collaboration with IGCAR along with professional bodies like ASC. New departments like school of excellence in Atmosphere Physics, Meterological Physics and Environmental physics can also be started. With this he concluded by encouraging the students.

Dynamics of this awareness program was given by Prof. Dr. A. Stephen, University of Madras, Secretary, ASC. The awareness program was conducted by Academy of Sciences for two reasons.

1. To promote science in higher educational institutions

2. To know the job opportunities offered by IGCAR/DAE.

Dr. B. Kanickairaj, Associate Professor, Dept. of Physics, St. Joseph's College delivered the vote of thanks for the inaugural session.

Inauguration of Exhibition

Dr. B. Venkatraman, Director, IGCAR, Kalpakkam inaugurated the exhibition on ANU Awareness with ribbon cutting along with Dr. A. Stephen, Secretary, ASC, Rev. Dr. K AMAL SJ, Secretary, St. Joseph's College & Rev. Dr. M. Arockiasamy Xavier SJ, Principal, St. Joseph's College. The technical team from IGCAR namely Smt. Jalaja Madan Mohan, Shri. Ramu, Shri Parthiban and Shri Jayakumar exhibited the models and charts which primarily focus on the nuclear reactor principles and history of nuclear energy in India.

This was followed by technical talk on Atoms in the Service of the Nation. This talk was delivered by Prof. Dr. B. Venkatraman, Director, IGCAR, Kalpakkam. The abstract of his talk is as follows. The usage of Nuclear Energy is roughly about 10%. But by 2070, this is bound to increase to about 40% to 50%. In United States of America More than 50% of the power is produced by nuclear. He mentioned that level of pollution in nuclear plants, is the least. It is one of the best in countries which have good resources of energy. Nuclear has contributed to net carbon savings of the planet. Around Giga ton of carbon dioxide has been avoided. The nuclear plant of 2000 MW capacity is nearing completion here. In Kudankulam, we were one of the earliest countries to realize nuclear energy in the long run will be a sustainable solution. Homi Baba formulated a three-stage program which today, internationally is accepted. Today World talks about generation four reactors. We talked about generation four reactors in 1940s and 1950s. That is why I say this is one of the most visionary departments. 1950s Baba could imagine that nuclear energy is going to play a role in the entire world. Not only are those, the radiations play a very important part in our society and day to day life. He also said that radiations have a great role to play and atoms are for peace and prosperity of mankind. Our reactors have the highest safety appreciation, longest and continuous operation also and holds high safety record worldwide. All our plants are very safe. The possibility of occurrence of any type of accident, as a layman, I would say is zero. The disaster will not happen because our reactors are designed for an earthquake on a richter scale of six to seven, for a tsunami, with a tidal wave for around six to 7 meters. And it happened. In Kalpakkam, during the tsunami, we lost 70 people in our township. Sunday morning, we were all there. We thought it's an earthquake. So people from the first floor started coming down to the ground floor. Everything was there. It was at that time, around 09:00 that the first wave strikes. It was a horrible thing. The wave just came in. The force was so much. That bulldozer was raised and thrown by half a kilometer. A bulldozer which is weighs few tons. Our constructions are all very good. So nothing happened. Plant was working perfectly fine. So it is a very safe. All of the reactors are very safe. We have double containment. The fuel is encapsulated in stainless steel structural material. We have outer containment. This containment is 1.2 meters thick concrete wall. So the question of accidents and releases are next to impossible. And all these things are for a minimum period of 60 years and extended up to 80 years. Today the oldest reactor in the country is Tarapur Atomic Power station. 1970 it started operating. It is still operating. Electricity from there is Rs1.50 per unit say. Even today it is being Kalpakkam atomic Power station gives roughly around Rs 2.40. Nuclear is definitely one of the clean powers. It is base load friendly. We have avoided 707,000,000 tons of carbon dioxide because we have switched to nuclear in certain areas. Today we are talking of vision 2047, when India would be 100 years since independence.

We have ten reactors under construction. And ten more reactors have been sanctioned in five more sites. So within 2047 we are going to have roughly about 15 to 20 Giga watts of electricity through the nuclear route.

Technical input session –II was discussed under the topic **Career Prospectus in the department of atomic energy,** which was delivered by Dr. Meenakshi, IGCAR, Kalpakam. In that session she explained the details about the various Job opportunities available for different levels in IGCAR. She also gave exposure regarding different competitive exams and their preparation methods. She also encouraged the students to join in IGCAR to serve the nation.

Quiz competition was conducted by **Dr. S. Chandrasekaran Head, HISD, HSEG, IGCAR** and their team at SAIL Hall at 2.00 PM. Students from 17 colleges participated. Simultaneously creative writing competition was conducted at PH-6 in Physics department, around 20 participants from various colleges participated.

DAY 2- 01st Dec

The ANU Awareness exhibition was opened for all participants at 10 .00 AM. Students from various schools and college students visited the exhibition. Mrs. Jalaja Madan Mohan Head, TCPAS, RESD, IGCAR delivered the talk on the basic of nuclear energy for human life to the participants. Slogan competition was also conducted by the IGCAR team for the students.

The valediction of the ANU Awareness program started at 3.00 PM with Prayer song. Dr. S. Lourdhuraj welcomed the gathering followed by the felicitation by **Dr. P. Rajendran**, Deputy Principal, St. Joseph's college. The valedictory address was given by Rev. Dr. Paulraj Micheal, Rector, St. Joseph's college who distributed the prizes for the winners of various competitions. In quiz competition Ist, IInd & IIIrd places were won by Bishop Heber college, Trichy, Holy Cross college, Trichy and St. Joseph's college, Trichy, respectively.

In creative writing competition Ist, IInd & IIIrd places were won by Seethelakshmi Ramasamy College, Trichy, Cauvery college for women, Trichy and Seethelakshmi Ramasamy College, Trichy, respectively.
