MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN

#### PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is made on this 12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2022 by and between St. Joseph's College, Tiruchirapalli-620 002 (hereinafter called SJC/First party) an Autonomous College which is part of a Society registered under Societies Regulations Act, 1860, on the ONE PART and TOSS Charitable Trust, B-78, Anna Nagar, Thennur, Tiruchirappalli – 620017 (hereinafter called TOSS/Second Party) on the OTHER PART. The SJC and TOSS are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as 'Party".

This MoU is being entered into between SJC and TOSS with the avowed objective of promoting Social Entrepreneurial Activities for the benefit of both the parties and the Society.

#### SCOPE

WHEREAS the Parties, having discussed the fields of common interest and other allied activities, have decided to enter into collaboration as outline below, but not limited to:

- Exchange of information by TOSS Charitable Trust with the faculty and students through periodical meetings.
- TOSS Charitable Trust will assist in improving Social Entrepreneurial activities and organizing Skill Development programs for St. Joseph's College students, which would be focused on Youth Empowerment.
- 3. Department of Business Administration, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli will assist by providing with student Volunteers and help produce future social leaders with humane attributes. Department of Business Administration, St. Joseph's College will offer support by providing Resource persons from their Teaching faculties for Social Events/Awareness Programmes.

### The above scope is expected to serve achievement of the following objectives:

- To equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge to cultivate Individual Social Responsibility (ISR).
- To conduct programs and activities that would improve the Social-Entrepreneurial skills of the students.
- To Provide Internship training and create an environment for college students directed at Self-Development with aspects related to Team building, Networking, Behavior Modelling and Leadership.
- 4. To provide seminars and hands-on experience with field experts, to bridge academics with social transformation.
- 5. To enable volunteer-ship programs modelled after the wholistic development of the students, thereby creating youth leaders.

#### PROGRAMME DEVELOPMENT

The members of the NGO will take part in the Conferences, Seminars and Workshops conducted by SJC for exchange of information. The staff and students of SJC will also take part in the conference, seminars and workshops conducted by the NGO. The Parties shall arrange facilitate field visits to the students and faculty.

Both the Parties shall periodically assess the needs and formulate plans for offering various joint venture programs to the outsiders also. The courses may be conducted at the Institute or outside the campus.

TOSS/Second Party shall facilitate establishment of a Social Entrepreneurship Development Cell at the premises of the First party for the benefit of new Social entrepreneurs. TOSS/the second Party shall support the Entrepreneurship Development Cell by sharing ideas on prospective business ventures, assessing project reports, guidance on bank loans, etc.

### BUDGET AND OTHER FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS

The expenditure incurred for the conduct of the workshops, seminars, and conferences for the members of the TOSS will be borne by the Second Party. Hospitality for the faculty coming for field visits and consultancy will be provided by the TOSS.

There will be no financial commitment to the TOSS / the Second Party for the in-plant training and field visits of students. The expenditure incurred for the conduct of the workshops, seminars, and conferences for the students of the institute will be borne by the institute.

### Implementation and Execution

The authorized representatives and the contact persons for the purpose of implementation and execution of the said MoU shall be the Head of the Department of Business Administration (BBA) of the First Party and the Managing Trustee of the second party or as may be deputed by the signatories of the Parties concerned from time to time.

The MoU shall be in force for three years from the date of signing, which may be extended thereupon by entering into appropriate agreement to the effect. In case either of the parties decides to terminate the agreement before the said period, one-month advance notice is to be given.

Either party may terminate this MoU at any time by giving a written notification signed by the signatory or the authorized representatives.

Any of the clauses/provisions of this agreement may be altered, amended, modified or deleted at any time by mutual consent of the Parties and thereafter all such amendments shall become part and parcel of this agreement. In case of any divergence in the conduct of functioning, a committee consisting of Chairman, TOSS and Principal, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous) - Tiruchirappalli will discuss the issue and their decision will be final and binding on both the parties.

This MoU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by the First Party and the other by the Second Party.

#### Memorandum of Understanding

The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. - 2.4 Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.5 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.6 Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.7 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.
- 2.8 There is no financial commitment on the part of the St. Joseph's College (Autonomous). Tiruchirappalli, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

#### CLAUSE 3

#### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### **CLAUSE 4**

#### VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid for maximum period of three years until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period CodeBind Technologies, Coimbatore the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of CodeBind Technologies, Coimbatore the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.

The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Tiruchirappalli.

#### **AND**

CodeBind Technologies, 601 C, 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Cross Cut Road, Gandhipuram, Coimbatore – 641 012, THE SECOND PARTY, and represented herein by its Branch Manager: Mr. Vaitheeswaran (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", a company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in – office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party' as)

#### WHEREAS:

A)	First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli – 620 002		
B)	CodeBind Technologies, the Second Party is engaged in software development and technical training.		
C)	First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.		
D)	The Parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation in areas of Skill Based Training, Education, Research and Placement.		
E)	Both parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.		

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information except confidential / trade information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

#### CLAUSE 2

#### SCOPE OF THE MoU

Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

- 2.8 There is no financial commitment on the part of the St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

#### **CLAUSE 3**

#### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### **CLAUSE 4**

#### VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid for maximum period of **three years** until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period *CodeBind Technologies, Coimbatore* the Second Party, as the case may be, will

take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of *CodeBind Technologies, Coimbatore* the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

#### **CLAUSE 5**

## RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any Divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Tiruchirappalli.
